VINCENT R TRIOLO SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

Rules

Eligibility: Student must be in Grade 8 and intending to attend a Catholic High School beginning in September of this year.

Parish Membership: Student must be a member of one of the following parishes located in the Town of Colonie: Christ Our Light, Our Lady of the Assumption, St. Ambrose, St Clare's, St Pius X. The Pastor or Director of Religious Education must confirm membership on the application. Applications without parish certification will not be considered.

Number of Scholarships and Amount: A total of three scholarships valued at \$500 each may be awarded. This scholarship is awarded only for the students first year at the Catholic high school.

Notification of Award: The Latham-Colonie Knights of Columbus #3394 will notify students who have been awarded a scholarship on or about June 15th. The school that is listed on the application will also be notified. The award will be paid after the high school notifies the Knights of Columbus that the student has enrolled and begun classes.

Parent/Guardian-Authorization: One of the custodial parents or guardians must sign the application granting permission of the applicant to participate and, if selected for a scholarship, grant the Latham-Colonie Knights of Columbus #3394 to publish or cause to be published the essay and picture of winners.

Required Essay: Each student must submit an essay on the following topic-"WHY I WANT TO ATTEND A CATHOLIC HIGH SCHOOL". The essay should be typed and be approximately 350 words in length.

Deadline: Application and essay must be received or post-marked no later than May 15th.
